A complaint charging JOHNATHAN WATSON ("Respondent") with violation of the Board of Respiratory Care Examiners' (the "Board") Practice Act has been received by the Board. In the interest of a prompt and speedy settlement of the above-captioned matter, consistent with the public interest, statutory requirements and the responsibilities of the Board, and pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.07 (F)(5), the undersigned parties enter into this Consent Agreement as a final disposition of this matter.

Based on the evidence before it, the Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent holds Board issued license number 044681 for the practice of respiratory care in the State of Arizona.
- 2. The Board initiated case no. 2020-RCE-0037 against Respondent after receiving notification from Respondent's former employer alleging that shortly after beginning his employment, Respondent repeatedly failed to report for his scheduled duty and failed to inform his supervisors that he would be absent.
- 3. Respondent began his employment with a medical center in Sun City, Arizona ("Employer") on March 28, 2022 and received a \$10,000 sign-on bonus.

3. Respondent failed to report for his scheduled training and shifts on the following dates and failed to notify Employer regarding his absences: March 29, 2022 (failed to report to training); April 4 and April 5, 2022 (failed to report for his shifts and did not notify his supervisors); April 19 and April 20, 2022 (failed to report for his shifts and did not notify his supervisors); April 26 and April 27, 2022 (failed to report for his shifts and did not notify his supervisors).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-3501, et seq., the Board has subject matter and personal jurisdiction in this matter.

The conduct and circumstances described in the Findings of Fact constitute unprofessional conduct as defined in A.R.S. § 32-3501(9)(i)(Any conduct or practice which is contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the respiratory therapy profession or any conduct or practice which does or might constitute a danger to the health, welfare or safety of the patient or the public) via A.A.C. R4-45-214(11) (Failing to report for scheduled duty without properly advising supervisory personnel) and A.R.S. § 32-3501(9)(k) (Violating or attempting to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisting in or abetting the violation of or conspiring to violate a provision of this chapter).

The conduct and circumstances described in the Findings of Fact constitute sufficient cause pursuant to AR.S. §§ 32-3552 and -3553 to take disciplinary action against Respondent's license to practice respiratory care in the State of Arizona.

However, in lieu of a hearing on these issues, Respondent admits the Board's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and agrees to issuance of the following Order and waives all rights to a hearing, rehearing, appeal or judicial review relating to this matter. Respondent further

waives any and all claims or causes of action, whether known or unknown, that Respondent may have against the State of Arizona, the Board, its members, officers, employees and/or agents arising out of this matter.

Respondent understands that the admissions in the Findings of Fact are conclusive evidence of a violation of the Board's Practice Act and may be used for purposes of determining sanctions in any future disciplinary matter.

Respondent understands the right to consult legal counsel prior to entering into this Consent Agreement and such consultation has been either obtained or is waived.

Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement is effective upon its acceptance by the Board or its designee and by Respondent as evidenced by the respective signatures thereto. Respondent's signature obtained via facsimile shall have the same effect as an original signature. Once signed by Respondent, the Agreement cannot be withdrawn without the Board's approval or by stipulation between Respondent and the Board's designee. The effective date of this Order is the date the Consent Agreement is signed by Respondent and accepted by the Board or its designee.

Respondent acknowledges and agrees that the acceptance of this Consent Agreement is solely to settle this Board matter and does not preclude the Board from instituting other proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

Furthermore, and notwithstanding any language in this Consent Agreement, this Consent Agreement does not preclude in any way any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings, investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to, violations of Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act.

Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the Board, this Consent Agreement makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views or intended actions of any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of the state relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent.
