10 The Arizona State Board of Respiratory Care Examiners (“Board”) is the duly constituted

24 3. Respondent’s current license to practice respiratory care was issued in 1997 and
25 expires on April 16, 2021.

26 4. Under A.R.S. § 32-3501, *et seq.*, the Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject
matter and over Respondent as a licensee of the Board.

5. On March 22, 2019, Respondent self-reported an employer reprimand on her
application for renewal.

12 served upon you. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 411092.09(B), you are notified that failure to file a
13 motion for rehearing or review at the Board's office by that date has the effect of prohibiting you
14 from seeking judicial review of the Board's decision
